


Activity Guide Zebra shape paper hats, ages 3-6



Materials Needed:

- 11x17 card stock paper
- Hole punch
- Yarn or elastic
- Colored markers



1. Print or draw shape and cut it out.




2. Color like crazy.



3. Fold the ears...



and roll the nose.



4. Hole punch and add the ties



5. Tie on yourself or your nearest friend!



Tips and Additional ideas

- Pre-cut shapes, hole punch and add ties to maximize coloring time.
- Let kids think outside the craft and transform shape into other things with strips of paper or other material.
- Demo the craft with the fold and roll so they understand the transformation ahead of time. Use a blank one so they know they can really go wild with their own ideas!





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
